Core Legal and Fiduciary Duties:

Duty of Care: Take care of the nonprofit by ensuring appropriate use of all assets, including facility, people, and goodwill.

Duty of Loyalty: Ensure that the nonprofit's activities and transactions are, first and foremost, advancing its mission; Recognize and disclose conflicts of interest; Make decisions that are in the best interest of the nonprofit corporation; not in the best interest of the individual board member (or any other individual).

Duty of Obedience: Ensure that the nonprofit obeys applicable laws and regulations; follows its own bylaws; and that the nonprofit adheres to its stated corporate purpose/mission.

General Board Member Responsibilities:

Strategic Planning: Establishing the organization's short- and long-term goals for the next 3-5 years based on outcomes of (planning sessions and holding the organization accountable to the plan.

Financial Oversight: Reviewing and approving an agency-wide annual budget, monitoring fiscal statements, and ensuring proper fiscal accountability.

Fundraising & Resource Development: Identifying strategic donors and diverse revenue sources to increase funding for the organization.

Executive Oversight: Hiring, supporting and conducting annual performance evaluations of the Executive Director.

Ambassador: Raise awareness of the organization in the community by attending community events and speaking about programs and services offered.
